

Andelin Family Farm



Andelin Family Farm has a plan to bring the farm to school kids this season. COVID 19 has disrupted a lot of things with schools, so we came up with an idea we are calling Mobile Field Trips!

Here is how it works:

- Teachers will schedule a mobile field trip day.
- Our staff will bring a pumpkin for each student to the school on the designated day.
- Teachers will get a link to our virtual farm tour video that is 25 minutes long to share with the students in class or over zoom.
- Each student will receive a coupon for a free child admission to our 2020 fall pumpkin patch, to visit with their family.

Here are the details:

1. Mobile field trips should be scheduled by emailing andelinfamilyfarm@gmail.com with 3 feasible dates for the pumpkin delivery, your school name and address and the estimated number of students for the field trip. Deliveries will be grouped geographically.

Mondays: West Reno	Thursdays: Reno/Sparks
Tuesdays: North Valleys	Fridays: Spanish Springs/Sun Valley
Wednesdays: South Reno	

Mobile Field Trips can be scheduled Mondays – Fridays between September 28 and October 29. No mobile field trips will be offered during fall break, the week of October 5th.

Please note: Our staff will bring pumpkins to the school and we request that you have bins for each classroom that we can put the pumpkins into at the front of the school. Our staff will wear masks and gloves. Our staff will not come into the school or classrooms. Pumpkins will be delivered to the front of the school and placed into your classroom bins.

2. When scheduling, teachers will need to provide an estimated number of students. We require a minimum 40 students at a school for us to come there. There is no maximum. The exact number can be determined within several days of the delivery date. We encourage you to coordinate with other classes and grades in your school.
3. The cost is \$6 per student and we will collect payment upon delivery with either check or credit card. We will also provide an invoice/receipt.

Contingency Plan

-What happens if school goes 100% distancing learning?

Teachers can continue the mobile field trip with some adaptations. Such as showing the virtual farm tour thru one of their distance learning sessions. Mailing the coupon to the students and they can receive the free small pumpkin when visiting the farm.

OR

Teachers can cancel the mobile field trip with an email sent with at least a week notice.
